

## **CCSS Scholarships**

Know a high school student or Delta College student who needs a scholarship? A scholarship program administered by CCSS, which includes up to ten merit-based awards, are given to graduating high school seniors and a San Joaquin Delta student each year. Students must be of Chinese descent, write an essay, submit a grade transcript and letters of recommendation along with a completed application to be eligible for any of the awards. Scholarship information will be available beginning in December/ January from counselors at each local high school within the San Joaquin County. Awards will be presented at the CCSS annual Spring Banquet in April.

Yosemite National Park is a large jewel in America's National Park System. In 2014, the Park will celebrate its 150<sup>th</sup> year since it was set aside as protected parkland. Famous men like John Muir and Ansel Adams are often associated with Yosemite. What is not often told are the contributions of Chinese Americans who played a role in the park's history. A short video produced by the Yosemite Conservancy and the park featuring Ranger Yenyen Chan has brought the incredible work of these Chinese Americans to light along with the story of Ah Sing, a cook who now has a peak named after him. The service of these men needs to be celebrated along with the park's anniversary.
